



After-school Classes

Using Encyclopedias

An encyclopedia is usually a book, or a set of books with articles about almost everything. One of the most famous ones is called *Encyclopedia Britannica*. It was first published in 1768 in the UK. The first one was mainly about science and sold out very quickly. Then the publishers decided to make the second one bigger. There were key events in history and the life stories of famous people in it. Also, *Encyclopedia Britannica* has made the jump online. That means you can read it in the library or on the go — anytime and anywhere.

Like dictionaries, the subjects are in alphabetical order. There are a number of books in large encyclopedias. Each of these books is called a “volume” and the subjects begin with the same letter. When using an encyclopedia, it is important to remember that names of famous people are listed by their last (family) names. So, you will find “Abraham Lincoln” under “L”, not “A”. The names of things beginning with “The” or “A” will not be found under “T” or “A”, but under the section of the first letter of the word directly after “The” or “A”. So the movie “The Island” will be found under “I”, and you will find it written as “Island, The”. Here is an example of an encyclopedia’s volume:
